#### The Bar Convent

York has many secrets but many visitors may not be aware of one of its best kept secrets. At a time when Catholicism had been made illegal by Queen Elizabeth1 a young woman Mary Ward was born in Mulwith Yorkshire, founded a religious congregation for women and started to establish schools across Europe. In 1630's The Catholic Church surpressed Mary's order, closed her schools and imprisoned her. It was 1686 before Mary was able to open a house in York which was the second school for girls and also a secret convent. It was 1769 before building work could start on the new Georgian frontage and eventually the parlour and the secret chapel was completed. From the outside not many people were aware of its well-hidden secrets and thankfully between 1778-1829 Laws against the Catholic faith were repealed. On your next visit try to see the relics of Margaret Cltherow, the priest hole and the Maw tiles which are the finest surviving in the world.
