York Minster

York Minster is one of the world's most magnificent cathedrals. Since the 7th century, the Minster has been at the centre of Christianity in the north of England and today remains a thriving church rooted in the daily offering of worship and prayer.

Adult General Admission Entrance Fee £16.00 General Admission Tickets for York Minster are valid for 12 months - Keep your ticket and return throughout the year!

The Minster and the Royal Connection

Discover York Minster's royal connections and collections through an exhibition exploring the cathedral's centuries-old relationship with the monarchy in celebration of the Coronation of King Charles III. The influence of the monarchy can be traced throughout York Minster's history. From the humble baptism of King Edwin of Northumbria on Easter Day in 627 in a small wooden church built hastily for the service – the first York Minster, to HM King Charles III's poignant return in November 2022 to unveil a statue of his late mother, Queen Elizabeth II.

Entrance to the exhibition is included with the general admission price.
