## **MOSI** and The Lowry

The Museum of Science and Industry Manchester is devoted to inspiring visitors through ideas that changed the world, from the Industrial Revolution Textile Gallery to the science of today and beyond. The museum is based at the site of the oldest surviving passenger railway station.

### The Lowry

The Lowry, situated in Salford is a world class arts centre offering a diverse programme of theatre, opera, musicals, dance, music, and visual art. The centre also displays a large collection of L.S. Lowry's iconic work. This artist is best known for his popular mill scenes, but his work also covers a wide range of themes and subjects.

#### The Imperial War Museum North

This is a unique purpose-built exhibition space giving a powerful voice to extraordinary stories of ordinary people, forced to live their lives in a world torn apart by conflict. Explore the timeline from the First World War to the present day, immerse yourself in the Big Picture Show, discover the forgotten histories of service personnel and civilians and see conflict through the eyes of artists.
