A Thought for Lent

Homelessness can never be a life choice. Rather it is devastating, dangerous and isolating. No one would choose to live in a tent erected in a shop front in the dead of winter.

The average of death for people experiencing homelessness is 45 for men and 43 for women. People sleeping on the street are 17 times more likely to be a victim of violence. The reasons for homelessness are many but some of them reflect the problems of society: poverty, domestic violence, family breakdown, lack of affordable housing and unemployment.
