Mass intentions

Charity for Easter

The collections for the Easter services will be going to LEPRA. This is an organisation dealing with the still existent scourge of Leprosy. LEPRA is a non-governmental organisation that promotes quality health care, initiates and fosters new developments and implementation. Their history dates to 1925, when the British Empire Leprosy Relief Association (BELRA) started leprosy work in India.

But this disease is curable. It costs LEPRA £25 to change a life and if found early enough and treatment is provided, the disease can be halted preventing disability. So, we shall do our best to make a difference.
